Two years on



In May 2019 the Twerton ward was changed to encompass the Whiteway estate and saw Tim Ball re-elected for a 9th term and he was joined by Sarah Moore.

During their election campaign, both Tim and Sarah spoke personally to a large number of residents across Twerton and Whiteway.

As Tim and Sarah are half way through their term we thought it would be good to look back at what they agreed to do for residents and what they have achieved so far.

As you will see they have delivered on most of the promises they made already and so we will also look at what they have planned for the next 2 years.

IN OUR AREA

Road resurfacing



One of the most common issues raised was the condition of our roads, Tim and Sarah are happy to confirm that over the last 2 years the following roads have been resurfaced:

Innox Road, The Brow, Highfield Close, Springfield Close, North View Close, Long Hay Close, How Hill, Watery Lane, parts of Shaws Way, parts of Redland Park, part of Newton Road and North Way.

West Close, St Michael's Road, East Close and East Way are scheduled to be completed shortly and Tim and Sarah have chased for the remaining sections of Newton Road and Shaws Way as well as Poolemead Road and Haycombe Drive to also be resurfaced.

A new crossing point has also been agreed on Poolemead Road

Freeview Road

Tim and Sarah were pleased to secure the funding (prior to the election) and get additional parking areas put in on Freeview Road. This was an issue for residents for so long it never looked as if the work would ever be done.

Not every area was able to be altered and this was due to ownership and services that ran beneath that meant they were not cost effective.

Park Improvements

New play equipment, benches, a notice board and trees/shrubs have been put in Innox Park and we are looking at additional footpaths to also be put in place. Funding has been secured for a Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) to be put in Rosewarn Park and Tim and Sarah are working closely with Curo are hopeful this will be put in place later this year.

Tim and Sarah are now looking to secure funding for enhancements at Pennyquick Park and will provide an update later this year.

We also had additional bins installed around the area, this was something that both Tim and Sarah as well as Rachel Willis campaigned on prior to the election.

Looking forward

Tim and Sarah's priorities for the next 2 years are to get the long awaited improvements on the High Street, fully consult all residents in the ward on Low Traffic Neighbourhoods, continue to push for road resurfacing and listening to residents on issues that are important to them.
