#### Pennyquick Park Update

Last Summer we asked residents to let us know what improvements they would like in Pennyquick Park, we requested funding be put forward in this year's budget and also put in a bid for



money from the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL).

Last year we helped plant a large number of trees and shrubs.

The park is long overdue an update and we are pleased to confirm we have managed to secure almost £60,000 funding for improvements to the park.

These funds will be used to enhance the pump track, install outdoor gym equipment as well as fully accessible picnic benches and also replace the toddler play equipment.

### **Shophouse Road**



Due to increased issues with speeding traffic and damage to parked vehicles we have requested that the police monitor traffic speeds on this road.

We are also looking at further measures that can be put in place to help slow the traffic on this very busy road.

#### **Redland Park**

We have again requested that this area have a deep clean and that weeds are removed from all the paths, we have had a response saying that this is being scheduled for late October and early November.

The new Foamstream natural weed removal system will be used, which is a 100% natural herbicide free blend of plant oils and sugars.



#### **Twerton High Street**



Following the recent Action In Mercy Pantry opening, we are pleased that a new lease has been agreed for the Two boarded up shops in the High Street and these will soon be opening up. We are also pleased that in the next few months work will begin on brightening the area with new planters and benches being installed along with increased cleaning. Talks

continue with Bath City and other developers in drawing up a master plan for the area to allow much needed redevelopment of the area.
